Thank you for your interest in the Psychologist Residency at Northwest ADHD Treatment Center!

Northwest ADHD Treatment Center is seeking full time post-doctoral residents to work at our locations in and around Portland, Oregon. We are a collaborative, team environment working in a multidisciplinary setting of clinical psychologists, LMFTs, LPCs, LCSWs, and psychiatric nurse practitioners.

Northwest ADHD Treatment Center offers unique and fulfilling opportunities to our clinicians by facilitating a group private practice model that allows for professional autonomy with an emphasis on work-life balance. This balance is achieved by leaving many of the non-clinical tasks in the hands of our administrative team which coordinates all scheduling, billing, credentialing, technological support and facilities maintenance.

The residency is designed to meet Oregon Board of Psychology requirements to attain Oregon Licensure within one year. Residents will have a designated supervisor, and at minimum will have one individual supervision hour, and one interdisciplinary group supervision hour per week. Weekly schedules are flexible, and can include regular time for assessment and research, in addition to clinical practice time.



## **Position Overview:**

Our ideal candidates are those who have expertise in treating adults, or in treating children and adolescents. Experience assessing and treating ADHD, as well as mood and anxiety disorders in an outpatient setting is highly preferred. Ideal candidates would have strong skills in differential diagnosis to rule in ADHD and rule out other mood, anxiety, developmental, or cognitive disorders. Experience in the administration of continuous performance tests and Wechsler measures are a plus. Strong candidates excel in time management, including accurate and concise documentation practices.

**This is a 12 month position with the potential to be hired full time after residency and licensure.**

Our postdoctoral residents will spend a significant amount of time assessing patients for ADHD and other mood disorders. They will also be responsible for administering the TOVA test related processes for the clinic on a weekly basis, possibly leading psychoeducational groups once per month, and seeing an average of 20 patients per week in our outpatient setting. This position includes weekly interdisciplinary group consultation time and direct supervision. Opportunities to engage in research may be available.

**Work Schedule:** 40 hours per week, to be further determined by site needs and resident preferences.

**Compensation:** Residents are offered competitive salaries plus benefits: including health, dental, and vision insurance, liability insurance, PTO. Residents may also be eligible for access to short and long term disability insurance, and research related stipends.



## Minimum Qualifications:

- PhD or PsyD degree
- Graduate of an APA-accredited program
- Completion of APPIC or APA-accredited internship
- After hiring, applicants must be in an approved Residency Contract with the Oregon Board of Psychology prior to commencing clinical work
- Ability to assess and treat ADHD
- Ability to work as an effective interdisciplinary team member
- Ability to maintain confidentiality in regard to patient care information
- Ability to maintain documentation in compliance with state, federal, professional and ethical guidelines
- Ability to consistently utilize professional communication and conflict resolution skills with patients and staff
- The candidate must receive their doctoral degree prior to submission of an Oregon Psychologist Resident Application, and is a requirement for start of employment
- **Dissertation must be complete to apply, ABD applications will not be considered**
